TIA’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA), pursuant to Section 1.46(b) of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“FCC” or “Commission”) rules, hereby submits a request for a 30-day extension of the deadline for filing comments in response to the above-captioned Petition, as well as a corresponding 30-day extension of deadline to file reply comments. Pursuant to this request, comments would be due July 25, 2007, and reply comments would be due August 24, 2007. The additional time is necessary for all parties to consider the issues raised by this Petition and prepare submission enabling the Commission to make an informed decision based on a fully developed record.

In addition to the reasons set forth in a motion filed by CTIA,¹ TIA believes this Petition and the issues that may or may not be addressed therein will have a significant impact on the information, communications and entertainment technology industry, as well as the public safety
